Please join Jeanne Block with the New Mexico Chapter of the Drug Policy Alliance regarding the development of a **State Methamphetamine Education Program.**

A \$500,000 grant obtained by U.S. Senator Bingaman (D-NM) through a Dept. of Justice appropriations bill will be used to develop a methamphetamine prevention campaign designed by and for youth, which will be broadcast on television and radio stations throughout New Mexico. You can help with the development of a statewide conference of educators, youth, parents, school counselors and nurses to train them in effective prevention strategies.

Jeanne will share a great 11 minute DVD interviewing kids and staff of the UpFront Program from Oakland, CA. It’s a great drug education and intervention program in the Oakland High School.
